How to Register: Simply complete the attached registration form in full and return it with full payment by mail or fax. Or phone or register online at www.nysscpa.org. Registration forms may be photocopied, but please use a separate form for each registrant. Payment may be made by check or may be charged to American Express, MasterCard, or Visa. All registrations must be received 14 days prior to the event in order to guarantee a seat and course materials. Allow approximately 14 days for your return confirmation. Registrants who do not receive a confirmation card before the conference must call FAE Registration to confirm registration status. Individuals who have not registered before the 14-day cutoff must call to determine space availability. Advance paid registrants will be seated first. For space availability and registration information, call FAE Registration at 212-719-8383 or 800-537-3635 from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Participants with special requirements should notify FAE staff at least 14 days in advance of the event. Pop Passes not accepted.

Refunds: No refund will be given for cancellations received less than two weeks prior to the program date. A \$50 processing fee will be deducted from refunds for cancellations received more than 14 days prior to the program date.

Transfers: FAE allows a registrant to transfer to another program or substitute another person without a penalty more than 14 days prior to the program date. Transfers and substitutions requested less than 14 days prior will be charged a \$25 processing fee.

Walk-ins: All individuals who register on the date of the program will be charged an additional \$25 processing fee.
