

How to Use the Online Publications Display Feature

Hello, and welcome to our new online publication display feature! Here are some quick tips to get you started:

- Set your Pop-up Blocker to allow all pages from this Web site by doing the following:
 1. In Internet Explorer, underneath the Address Bar, click the Information Bar when it notifies you that a pop-up window has been blocked.
 2. Click **Always Allow Pop-ups From This Site**.

You can also do the following:

1. Open Internet Explorer.
 2. On the **Tools** menu, point to **Pop-up Blocker**, and then click **Pop-up Blocker Settings**.
 3. In the **Address of Web site to allow** box, type **viewers.zmags.com**, and click **Add**.
- In order to get started viewing your online publication, simply click on a page to zoom in, and then use the arrows on the left and right sides to navigate through the publication. Move your mouse up and down to scroll on the page, and zoom in and out using the scroll wheel on your mouse. You can then click once inside the page to zoom back out. In the zoomed out mode, you can even turn the pages by grabbing the corners while holding down the mouse button and turning the page over, or by clicking once on the corners.
 - In the zoomed out mode, you can utilize the feature buttons in the bottom toolbar. If you can't see the toolbar, try viewing your browser in **Full Screen**. You can mouse over the buttons to see what each one does. The buttons include:
 - **Go to Table of Contents:** Here you can see each page of the publication and choose which one to go to.
 - **Go to the front cover:** Here you can return to the first page of the publication.
 - **Search the publication:** Here you can search through the entire publication for a specific word or phrase.
 - **Page Selector:** Here you can use the arrows to move back and forth through the zoomed out publication, and you can also type in a specific page number to go directly to that page.
 - **Image Clipping:** Here you can use a box to clip a specific part of a page and then either save it to your computer, or e-mail it to a friend.
 - **Tell a friend about this page:** Here you can e-mail the current page to a friend.
 - **Print publication:** Here you can choose either one or multiple pages to send to the printer. Simply select the pages you want to print, or select them all to print the whole publication.
 - **Download the publication as a publication:** Here you can download either one or multiple pages to your computer as a PDF document. Simply select the pages you want to download, or select them all to download the whole publication.
 - For more help, click "?" at the top right.
 - Click the "X" at the top right to close the window.
