## Tips for Estimated Tax

For instructions, see Form IT-2105-I, *Instructions for Form IT-2105, Estimated Income Tax Payment Voucher for Individuals*, or Form IT-2105-I-F, *Instructions for Form IT-2105, Estimated Income Tax Payment Voucher for Fiduciaries*.

To help us match your New York State estimated tax account to your New York State income tax return and avoid a delay in processing your return, please note the following:

**Identification number** — Make sure that the identification number used on your vouchers agrees with the number on your social security card or fiduciary records. The identification number used on your New York State income tax return must also agree.

**Name** — Make sure that your name or the name of the estate or trust is spelled correctly. An individual should show the first name, middle initial, then last name (i.e., John O. Smith). Your name or the name of the estate or trust **must** agree with the name on your New York State income tax return.

**Married taxpayers filing a joint New York State income tax return** — If your last name differs, you should establish an estimated tax account in the name and social security number of the primary taxpayer to ensure proper account crediting.

**Married taxpayers filing separate New York returns**  
To ensure proper credit for your payments, you should establish separate estimated tax accounts.

**If you do not want your refund credited to the next year's estimated tax**, *do not* enter any figures in the space provided for this election on your income tax return. Once you make an election to credit an overpayment to the following year's tax, you cannot change it.
